(Note from Pam: I believe that the message Woody gave in this letter is very important to us believers at this time in our lives, our Church, our nation, our world. It is a word specifically about 2009. Please take what is written to heart and ask God to give you understanding and wisdom concerning His Word.)

Dear Partner,

Thank you so much for your faithful support and prayers. During this time of economic shaking, we are tied to another economy that is not in recession — that is the economy of HEAVEN (Phil. 4:19). It is very important that we don't pull back from planting our financial seeds of faith. We must remember that as long as the earth remains there is seedtime and harvest (Gen. 8:22). It may be a time of famine; but, like Isaac, we can sow in a time of famine and reap a one hundredfold in the same year (Gen. 26:12).

This past month I have ministered in Kentucky, Louisiana, Kansas, and Maine. We have seen people saved, healed, and delivered. **I was so blessed to see a man I have been praying years for to receive Christ as Savior come to the Lord!** Both he and his wife graciously have allowed me to stay in their ocean view apartment above their business every time I have ministered in the area. Yet, he never attended one of my services, until the other night when he received Christ. It is such a joy to see people come to Christ and to know that I have been part of the process. YOU have been part of God's process, too, through your giving and prayers for Woodson Ministries.

God has given me three key words for 2009 that I would like to share with you. First, the Lord spoke to me that we must

— ALIGN IN 2009 —

He said that the Body of Christ was experiencing great pain because it was out of alignment. We must get in alignment. We must begin to *“seek FIRST the kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these things will be added”* (Matt. 6:33). We must *“walk by faith, not by sight”* (2 Cor. 5:7); seek the spiritual, not the natural; set your minds on the things above, where Christ is, not on the things that are on earth (Col. 3:1, 2). We need to align more with heaven, and then we can pray that God's kingdom would manifest on earth as it is in heaven — His will would be done here in our midst, in our lives. When we order our lifestyle aright, He will show His salvation (Ps. 50:23). Just as it is if a physical body gets aligned, or gets adjusted, sometimes a little adjustment will take away a lot of pain.

The second word God gave me is that as we align with Him, we should expect a move of God's spirit and

— RESTORATION —

I believe that this year God is going to restore vision, restore the joy of salvation, restore families (prodigals are coming home!), restore health, and restore wealth. God spoke to me that I have taught wrongly about the key to restoration. I had heard for years that the restoration of all things was tied to the restoration of the tabernacle of David, emphasizing praise and worship. The Lord spoke to me that, yes, it is important to praise and worship Him and that He is restoring the tabernacle of David, but it is the restoration of the message of THE KINGDOM OF GOD that causes the restoration of all things. Matthew 6:33 says to seek first the kingdom and *all things* will be added to you. Kingdom first, then restoration. I believe that God the King is going to restore the wasted years — in one major outpouring of the Spirit, we will be where we would have been if life had been smooth and perfect (Joel 2:21-29).

The third and last word God gave me was

— RECOVER —

This year we may feel like David when he lived in Ziglag (in overwhelming despair, which is what "Ziglag" means). He and his men left the city to go to battle. While they were gone, the enemy came in, burned their houses, and stole their families and possessions. Upon returning and seeing this, the men wept till they had no more strength to weep. They wanted to stone David to death because he had led them into battle, leaving their families and homes unprotected. David did two things that we must do to have a recovery: 1) He encouraged himself in the Lord, and 2) he enquired of the Lord.

As he did these two things, God spoke to Him. The word David received from the Lord is the word for us in this hour. God told him to pursue the enemy and that he would recover all. God is saying to the Church: *Get on the offensive...Use your faith...Take out the sword of the Spirit, the Word of God, and go into the enemy's camp and take back what he has stolen.* When David went forward and pursued the enemy, he recovered what had been stolen. Not only that, God turned the attack of the enemy around...and David became a very wealthy man. Believe that if you will get aggressive with your faith, God can enable YOU to recover. He can turn your situation around. Remember — Matthew 11:12 states that *"the kingdom of heaven suffers violence, and the violent take it by force."* (For more on "recovery," see 1 Samuel 30.)

Pam and I are praying for you. We are believing that you will align with God in 2009. We are believing with you for this year to be a year of restoration and recovery. While the earth is getting darker, God's people will arise and shine!

We love you and pray God's best for your life.
